



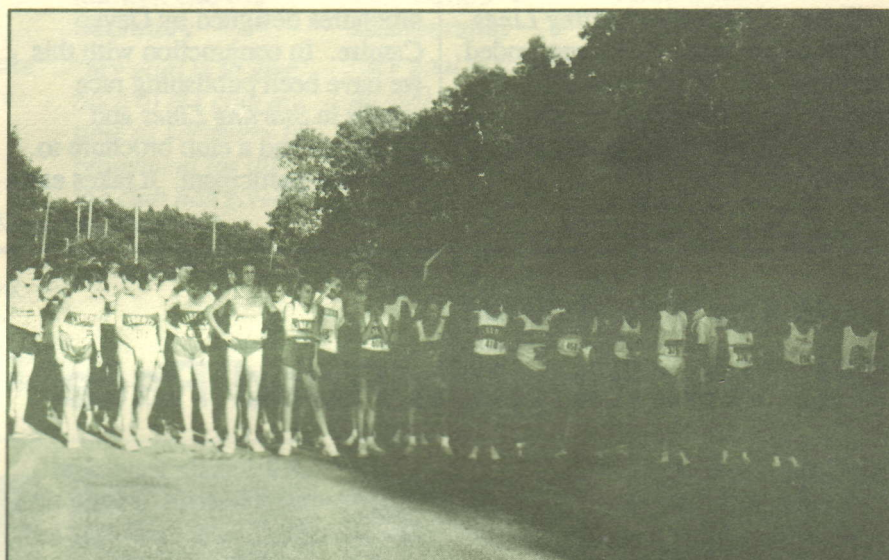

# Coors Light Great Legs Race

Lowell, Mass -- The 5KM Great Legs Road Race is on its way to becoming one of the largest and nationally competitive all-women's races in the United States. This year's field of approximately 500 women was led by Christine Pfitzinger of New Zealand who ran the 3000 meters in the 1988 Olympics. Pfitzinger clinched the twilight victory with a time of 16:28, eight seconds of the course record set by another Olympian Darlene Beckford in 1987.

Ann Marie Marino of Rhode Island was second at 17:14 and Jeffy Hamilton of North Reading, Mass. was third at 17:26. The Great Legs Road hosted by the Greater Lowell Road Runners and sponsored by Coors Light and James L. Cooney Realty benefits the House of Hope, a shelter for

## Boston Marathon - 1990

This was my first Boston Marathon. I have run three other marathons - my third being almost five years ago in Portland, Maine. I have never done well in the heat, and April 16th was no different. It's too bad the 10 weeks of training wasn't reflected in my finishing time. Circumstances and weather were against me.

This is an event that I will never forget. The participating in, and finishing of, the 94th Boston Marathon - it isn't easy to put into words. Now that it's all over, and I've had time to reflect and remember the events of the day (some things I didn't remember for a few days), I would like to share my highlights.

The ride to Hopkinton on the bus. The talk on the way of training schedules and the hopes of the day. What great camaraderie. The crowd at the start - so many runners in one place. The sea of runners that stretched out in front. The whole world is watching this event. The best marathon runners in the world are running on the same course today. The crowds

along the route. Why was I only at 35:51 on my watch at 4 miles? The girls in Wellesley. The balloons my wife sent and the good luck card from my daughter and her friends at UMass. The blister that started on my right foot at 13. The lady playing the accordion and singing God Bless America. The Dixieland Band on the rooftop. The rock band in a side yard. What superb medical, water stop and general support by the B.A.A. The pain. The friendly faces. The high five slaps from the kids. All those boom boxes and the music coming out of the houses. The pride. All the extra water from the public. Heartbreak Hill. Those three hills before Heartbreak. The three miles of downhill after Heartbreak. My legs ached. The faces of my friends along the route. The heat - oh God, the heat. The disappointment in having to walk. The running down Boylston Street and crossing the finish line. The pride. The desperate search for my family. Attempting to step onto the sidewalks by stepping over those three foot tall Boston curbstones. The search for the handicap cut in the curbstones. The aches. The comfort of the silver security blanket given at the finish. The hot tub water at home that night. A sunburn too! All the calls from friends and family wanting to know how I did. The pride. The agony of going downstairs. Looks like I'll lose two toenails. The 4 mile jogs the next few days. The pain. How could I lose 10 pounds after all that water I drank? How come it has taken me almost a week to start to feel normal and be able to run a comfortable 7 miles? Boston is TOUGH - no question!

What will I remember best - you're right - THE PRIDE. Was it worth it? Absolutely. Will I do it again? Absolutely not.....well.....maybe!

## How Boston Almost Finished Me

It was the Monday after the New Bedford Half Marathon; John called me and said that he could get me a number for Boston. I thought this was great, after all I ran the Rhode Island Marathon in the fall and just missed qualifying by two minutes. It wasn't my fault that the Rhode Island Marathon people put hills in the course and it was a windy day. If it wasn't for those unfair conditions, I probably could have run five minutes faster.

When I got off the phone, my wife reminded me that I had not been training to run a marathon. My response was "I have plenty of time! The marathon is four weeks away; that's three weeks of training and one week to rest before the marathon." (first stupid mistake). So I began to plot out my training schedule. The key would be to get in three quality long runs. Training went well, if I do say so myself. My long runs were 19, 20 and 15 miles. For weekly mileage I did 53, 60 and 45 miles. With this kind of training I was ready to handle whatever the race had to offer (second stupid mistake).

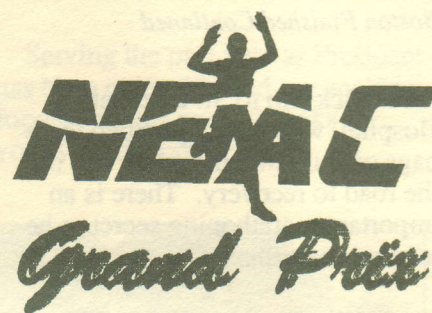
### "BRING ON BOSTON"

Race day came, and as we all know, it was perfect conditions for a marathon - sunny (not a cloud in the sky) and the temperature was in the mid 60s. Who could not run a good race on a day like that? When the gun went off to start the race, I was sure that I would finish. The only question was how fast it would be - 3:20? 3:30? If I had a bad day, 3:40. I went through the two mile mark at an 8 minute pace. My thoughts were that I should be able to handle this pace and might have a shot at running a 3:30 marathon or faster.

At the first water station, I drank some water and started having stomach pain. I decided then that the smart thing to do would be not to drink any more water (THIRD STUPID MISTAKE). I then started making my way through the pack. Things were going well; I didn't feel well, but my clever strategy of not drinking water was working. My splits were getting better each mile. After 5 miles, I was well under the 8 minute pace. This was going to be my day!

At 10 miles, the running started to get a little tougher, but I was keeping pace. The miles just started getting harder and harder after that. Around mile 15, I knew I was in trouble, but I'm tough - I can make it. At mile 19, I was forced to start walking and jogging, but I'm tough - I can make it. Mile 22, I'm tough - I can make it. Mile 23, I'm tough.....

The next thing I know, I'm in a medical tent. I'm listening to the conversation above me: ".....blood pressure is 90 over 60 and we can't get a pulse; get the ambulance".

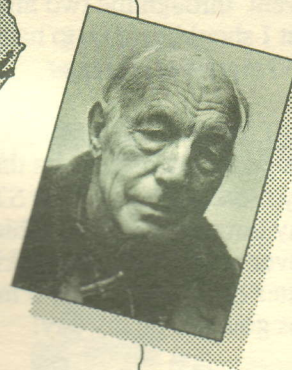



# Great Legs Sets Record

Friday the 13th was no curse for the Coors Light Great Legs Road Race as a record 500 women bolted across the starting line at Cawley Stadium in this ninth annual celebration of women's running.

Christen Pfitzinger, a 1988 3000 meter Olympic contender, also overpowered the jinx and the rest of the field, running the 3.1 mile course in 16:28 -- eight seconds off the course record set by Darleen Beckford in 1987. Rhode Island resident, Ann Marie Marino came in second at 17:14 and Jeffy Hamilton of North Reading was third at 17:26. Mary Jane Boyd carried the banner for Greater Lowell, placing 20th overall with a time of 18:39.

Sixty teams participated in the race including 19 mother/daughter duos and 21 sister/sister teams. Liberty Athletic Club placed first in both the open and masters' team competition. Greater Lowell masters garnered a second place finish followed by Central Mass. Striders in third place and Gate City in fourth. In the open category, CMS posted a second place with the Winners Circle Running Club in the third spot. Susan Aronovitz and Ann Kucharski topped the sister/sister division category clocking 38:31. Ann and Tracy Sipka top the mother/daughter division clocking a 40:11.

The record breaking moment of the night came before the race got underway as the computerized list of runners closed in on the 600 mark. An elated Jean Boswell watched post-entries pile up to

nearly double last year's field of some 300 runners. This represents a 300 percent increase over a nine year span. In 1981 less than 200 women toed up to start the Great Legs, billed as "part of the movement to have a women's marathon, 10KM and 5KM added to the Olympics."

"I am thrilled," said Boswell as club President Mary Bourret presented her the silver Revere bowl in appreciation of her efforts on behalf of women runners. "I am more thrilled," she added, "that 600 of you came here tonight." Under Boswell's direction the race has grown steadily for the past three years and is now ranked as the second largest all women's road race in New England. Boswell will turn the 1991 directorship of the Great Legs over to Christina Bellinger of Newburyport.

A contingent of vendors and a DJ spinning a bottomless supply of compact discs added to the festive

air at the stadium. The near perfect 70 degree weather was a come-on for friends and relatives who showed up in droves to cheer their favorite runner.

In addition to bringing a record crowds of runners, walkers and spectators to the city, the Great Legs brought comfort to an unspecified number of women with a generous donation to the House of Hope, a shelter for homeless women and children in Greater Lowell.

Meanwhile the GLRR men took up posts as cheer leaders and traffic managers on the course, dished up delectables at the finish line and coerced the computers into compiling quick and accurate race results. Thanks guys! And thanks to the contingent of behind-the-scene women who have worked year in and year out to make the Great Legs a premiere road race. Good work! See you next year.
